

Task 1:

- 1) Book Cover (Draw an important scene)
- 2) Book title and name of the author
- 3) A short summary of the book (100-120 words)
- 4) Your favourite lines from the book
- 5) Was there any similarity between Neel and the tiger cub? Explain.
- 6) Who was the most relatable character? Why?
- 7) Who was your least favorite character? Why?
- 8) The reason why you liked this book

Get creative and make a colorful book review using A4 size sheets.

Task 2:

Write a short story (500-1000 words) about someone who finally learnt how to do something after many failed attempts. In the story, highlight their desire to learn, their barriers to learning, their struggles and how they overcame that.

Imagine that dogs take over the world. What do they make humans do? Write a paragraph of about 100-120 words.

<u>Task 4:</u>

Imagine you just won the Nobel Prize for Literature and are now being asked to deliver a speech to the audience. Write the speech in about 300-500 words.

- 3. Find out the amount of each of the nutrients present in them.
- 4. Note down your observations with their units in your tabular data.
- From your observation, find out which food items are good or bad for your health.

Creativity: Make products of your own e.g. "A healthy drink" by using Fruits and vegetables.

- 6. Name your product. Make a tabular data of your product and find out the nutrients present in it.
- 7. Calculate the cost of the natural source of nutrients used in making your food.
- 8. Compare the cost of your product with other packed items. Find out which one is costlier.
- 9. Compare the contents of nutrients, between the packed drink with the drink or you made out of fruits or vegetables and tell us which one is healthier and why?
