Also include sketches or photos to complement your journal to make it look attractive and creative.

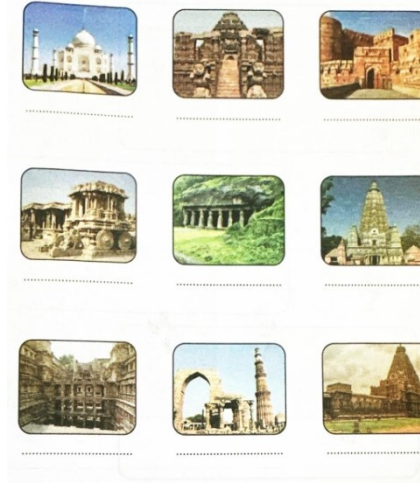

Activity 1: Make working Models of different types of angles with IceCream sticks.

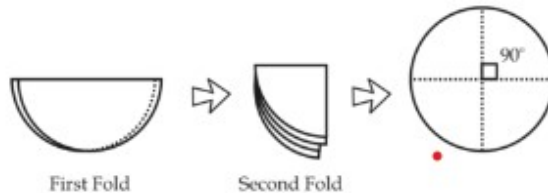
Instructions: Use ice cream sticks, cardboard, coloured sheets etc for making a modal.
